



Frequently asked questions:

1. What types of studies are included within the “clinical research” area?

For this RFA, studies that focus on outcome measures, pharmacological therapies, behavioral therapies, therapeutic programs, clinical service delivery, population science, community outreach and interactions, and educational plans would likely fall within this category. Some studies of biomarkers may also qualify for this category.

2. Are all human based studies considered clinical research?

No, not at all. Studies of the brain’s structure, connectivity, and activity are all considered basic science, and these may include use of sMRI, fMRI, DTI, MRS, MEG, EEG, ERP, and eye tracking, or use of tools to assess sensorimotor or other neural functional modalities.
