

## 50/50 Raffle FAQ's:

- What is the Eagles 50/50 Charity Raffle?
  - A raffle lottery in which half of the jackpot will go to one lucky winner and the other half will support Eagles Autism Challenge, Inc.
- What is Eagles Autism Challenge?
  - The Eagles Autism Challenge is dedicated to raising funds for innovative research and programs to help unlock the mystery of autism. By providing the necessary resources to doctors and scientists at leading institutions, we will be able to assist those currently affected by autism as well as future generations. - How old do you need to be to purchase raffle tickets?
  - No one under the age of eighteen (18) years old may purchase a 50/50 Drawing ticket or claim a prize.
- Can I buy tickets with a credit card?
  - Purchase of tickets may be made by cash or, in certain locations only and if available, credit card or debit card.
- Where can raffle tickets be purchased?
  - Raffle tickets can be purchased from any of the kiosks or roving sellers located throughout the stadium.
- How much do raffle tickets cost?
  - 3 tickets for \$5.00, 10 tickets for \$10.00 and 40 tickets for \$20.00. Each ticket purchased will represent one entry in the Drawing.
- When do sales begin and end?
  - Ticket sales will begin when gates open and conclude at the start of the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter.
- When will the winning ticket be announced?
  - In the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter, approximately ten minutes after raffle sales end.
- Where can I see the gross prize amount throughout the game?
  - Throughout the game, you can check the gross prize amount to the right of both the North End Zone and South End Zone scoreboards. The live jackpot will also be displayed on a monitor at each 50/50 kiosk, as well as on TV screens throughout the concourse and club levels.
- Must I be present to win? And how does the winner claim the prize?
  - The winner does not need to be present to win. The prize may be (a) claimed in the Head House Lobby Ticket Office in the Head House Plaza within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the applicable practice/game, or (b) be claimed with an appointment at the Eagles Autism Challenge office, within 30 days following the last Philadelphia Eagles game (regular season or post-season) of the season during which the winning ticket was drawn.

- Are taxes withheld from the winnings?
  - Yes
  
- What tax forms do I need to obtain/file?
  - You will need to fill out a W-9 form when you claim your prize. Additionally, all prize winners will receive an IRS Form W-2G sent to the address on the winning ticket claim form for tax filing purposes.
  
- What are the tax implications of winning the drawing?
  - The IRS requires us to withhold federal taxes at a rate of 24% for winnings over \$5,000. If you fail to provide a taxpayer identification number, backup withholding of 24% is required for all prizes over \$600. Federal taxes for prizes under \$5,000, and all state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner.
